**Facility:**

- ◆ 10 competition lanes with a separate warm down pool.
- ◆ Locker rooms and showers
- ◆ Fully automated 10 lane Colorado timing system
- ◆ Ample seating for competitors and spectators
- ◆ Meet Manager and Colorado Timing console/touchpads will be used to conduct the meet.

Damage to the facility, when proven, will cause the offending swimmer, and their school district, to be held accountable for repairs.

**Times/Dates:** This is a prelims/finals meet with timed finals for relays and a single round for diving competition. The top eight swimmers in each individual event will advance to finals on Saturday. Relays will be swum on Saturday during finals.

Diving - Thursday, January 26<sup>th</sup>  
- Warm-up at 6:00 p.m. (11 dive format)  
- Diving Competition will start at 7:00 p.m.

Prelims - Friday, January 27<sup>th</sup>  
- Swimming warm-up at 9:00 a.m.  
- Swimming Competition at 11:00 a.m.

Finals – Saturday, January 28<sup>th</sup>  
- Swimming warm-up at 9:00 a.m.  
- Swimming Competition at 11:00 a.m.

Coach's Meeting @ 10:00 am on Friday (if not conducted at the District Entry Meeting).

**Cell phone****Restrictions:**

- ◆ The presence and / or use of cell phones, and / or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms or changing areas is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times.
- ◆ There are no exceptions to this prohibition.
- ◆ Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest.

**Rules:**

- ◆ 2011 – 2012 National Federation and U.I.L. Contest rules will apply
- ◆ Championship format, i. e., preliminaries and finals, with the top eight swimmers in individual events advancing to finals on Saturday.
- ◆ Seeded with individual's competitive time or NT.
- ◆ A Meet Committee of five (5), appointed by the Meet Director (two officials, two coaches and one athlete), will be the final authority on issues referred to it under authority of the Federation Rules.
- ◆ The Federation Whistle Start Procedure will be in use at this meet.
- ◆ The Federation "No Recall" false start protocol will be in use at this meet.

**National Time****Verification:**

- ◆ This meet has been approved by USA Swimming for NTV purposes.
- ◆ In order for a time from a high school championship or season ending meet to be entered into the USA Swimming (USA-S) National SWIMS Database, the athlete must be currently registered with USA-S – AND – the athlete's full legal name USA Swimming ID Number must be accurately entered into the District 25-4A Meet Manager Database.
- ◆ No further action by either the coach or the athlete is necessary.
- ◆ ALL swims involving the backstroke will be observed by USA Swimming Certified Officials and exceptions to the technical rules will be noted to the NTV Officer on deck.

**Awards:**

- ◆ Custom Awards: Championship Team, 1<sup>st</sup> for Girls and 1<sup>st</sup> for Boys
- ◆ Medals: 1st - 3rd (Every Event)
- ◆ Ribbons: 4th - 8th (Every Event)

**Eligibility:**

- ◆ All athletes must meet the current UIL eligibility requirements.

**Entries:**

- ◆ Submit Hy-Tek Commlink File or disk.
- ◆ Hard copy must be included.
- ◆ Diving sheets must be delivered to the Diving Referee no later than one hour before warm-ups.
- ◆ Burnet C.I.S.D. cannot accept meet entries without fees attached.
- ◆ Relay entries are limited to one per relay event.
- ◆ Teams are limited to four entries per individual event.
- ◆ Each swimmer may swim a maximum of four events, but no more than two may be individual events.

**RELAYS:**

- ◆ Up to Eight (8) individuals may be designated on back of the relay card, but it will not count as an event unless that individual actually competes on the relay team.
- ◆ Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are to report to the blocks and compete.

- ◆ In case of illness or injury to one of the four swimmers, it shall be reported to the Meet Referee and any one of the remaining swimmers designated on the entry card may replace the ill/injured swimmer provided she/he does not exceed the allowable entries. The ill/injured swimmer shall not be charged with an entry.
- ◆ If the swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Final Results, the order of swimming must also be specified.
- ◆ Relay cards for the 200 yard Medley Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the beginning of the coaches' meeting.
- ◆ Relay Cards for the 200 Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer no later than the start of the men's 500 yard freestyle.
- ◆ Relay cards for the 400 yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer no later than the start of the men's 100 yard Backstroke.
- ◆ Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, no changes will be permitted and post-meet corrections cannot be made.
